## Spotlight Of One Of Our Own!

The Spotlight for the October-November 2019 issue falls on our Chaplain, Elgart Baumann.

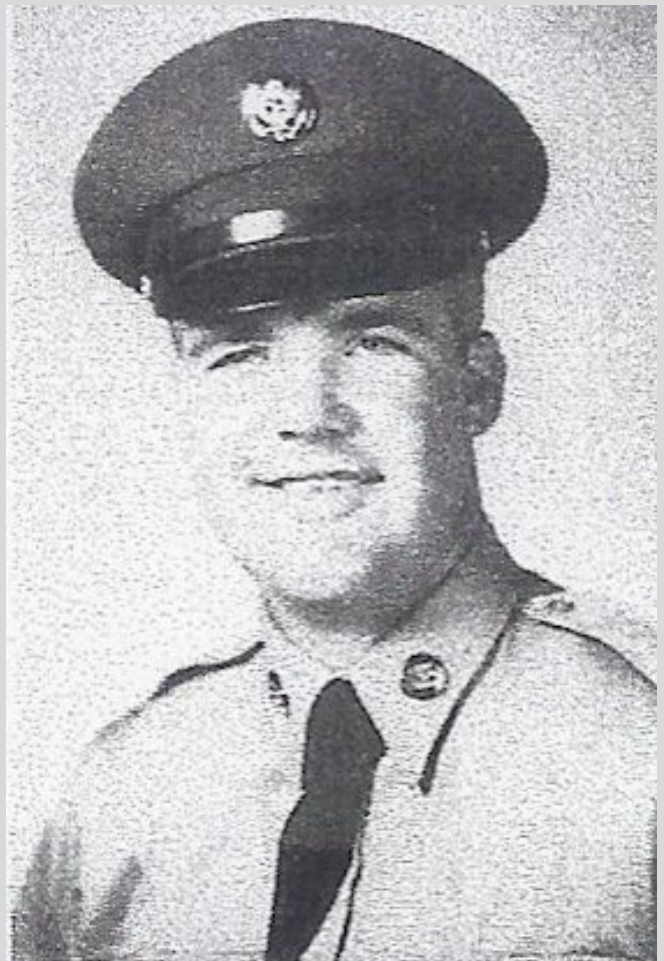
Elgart was born and raised in Wausau and graduated from Wausau High School in June of 1961. After High School Elgart attended the Wausau Technical Institute (NTC) where he learned off-set printing and graduated from there in 1963.

Being drafted in June of 1964 Elgart went to basic training at Fort Leonard Wood in Missouri and because of his training and expertise in printing he was able to bypass his advanced individual training. As a Letter and Plate Pressman, Elgart was directly assigned to the printing section at Fort Lee in Virginia. He spent the remainder of his Army hitch at Fort Lee printing top secret documentation about the goings on in an ever heating up conflict, called Viet Nam. While in service Elgart attained the rank of Specialist fourth class E-4, was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal and qualified as Marksman with the M-14 rifle.

Elgart returned to Wausau after his service and in 1967 married Eunice his lovely wife of fifty two years and counting. Together they have three children, one son, two daughters, and one grandson. Elgart worked at his chosen profession for the next few years at Wilson Hurd, but as technology progressed the printing industry declined. Elgart was hired by the city of Wausau as a Heavy Equipment Operator and for the next thirty three years did so until his retirement.

For the past five years Elgart has been our Chaplain, the first three years splitting time with Shirley Bickford, but for the last two years has been the man. Listen to the words at the beginning of each meeting as Elgart helps us to remember our past, be thankful for what we can do in the present and mindful of the future. For your strong words, your devotion to your fellow Veterans and for the caring that is in your voice

when you speak to us, you bring great honor to yourself your family and our great organization. For these reasons the Man of Honor Society of Marathon County salute you and are proud to have you as a member and in the spotlight.





## **Veterans Day - Monday, November 11, 2019**

Veterans Day celebrates the service and sacrifice of all U.S. military veterans. Whether you are retired, separated, active duty, guard, reserves – this day is for you!

Many restaurants and companies thank our veterans and actively serving military personnel for their service with a free meal or discounts. This year Veterans Day falls on a Monday, giving many people a three day weekend.

### **Veterans Day Free Meals Deals**

Before you go, remember four things.

1: You will need some form of ID. Most companies require some form of military ID before giving you the discount. Usually a military ID card (Common Access Card, or CAC), Retired ID card, VA ID Card, current Leave and Earnings Statement (LES) pay stub, drivers license with veterans designation, DD214, discharge paperwork, veterans organization card (i.e., American Legion, VFW), photograph of yourself in uniform, a citation or commendation, or going in uniform while be sufficient.

2: Not all locations participate. While the overall franchise or corporation may offer a Veterans Day free meal or discount, a specific location may not participate. It never hurts to call ahead and ask before you're seated so you are not surprised when the check comes.

3: Leave a nice tip! Don't stiff your waitress or waiter, they're still working just as hard whether your meal cost \$100 or \$0. Thank them with a nice tip!

4: This isn't a right or a privilege, but a gesture of thanks. If a corporation or restaurant chooses not to participate in the Veterans Day discounts or doesn't have the item you wanted available, don't throw a hissy fit. Please act like an adult. Be gracious and thankful that some organizations and companies are giving you a discount and celebrating your service on Veterans Day. Please don't abuse this great benefit of military service that private organizations, companies, and business owners choose to give to us.

If you act entitled to perks like this, people will soon sour on giving them away. Be grateful, kind, and generous when you tip!
